RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A LIVINGSTON COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL HOME VISIT FEE FOR RELEASE OF RABIES QUARANTINE - ANIMAL CONTROL

WHEREAS, Michigan Department of Community Health, MDCH, rabies protocol for a person that is bitten by a dog or cat is to be confined for 10 day quarantine for rabies observation.

WHEREAS, Livingston County Dog Ordinance, Article 6, Section 7, states at the expiration of a dog's or cat's quarantine period, the owner shall bring the dog or cat to the Animal Shelter for health inspection and completion of required forms.

WHEREAS, LCAC officers are not getting compliance with pet owners bringing dog/cat to shelter for health inspection and are having to make home visits to clear dogs or cats from quarantine.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorize the adoption of a fee for \$50 for home visits for owners that that do not bring pet in for viewing after 10 day rabies vaccination.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other fees at Animal Control/Animal Shelter remain in effect as authorized.
