RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF LIVINGSTON AND BONNITA A. DETWEILER FOR BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SERVICES - Department of Public Health / Personnel Committee / Health & Human Services

- WHEREAS, Livingston County has a need for business management services for the Livingston County Department of Public Health (LCDPH); and
- WHEREAS, LCDPH currently has a vacant Business Manager position which it does not wish to fill for budgetary reasons and the proposed Contractor has 31 years experience in business management and can provide the necessary services cost effectively; and
- **WHEREAS,** the proposed Contractor can provide services for approximately one day per week in financial reporting, budgeting, contract management, and audit review; and
- WHEREAS, Bonnita A. Detweiler of Howell, Michigan, will provide business management services for the Livingston County Department of Public Health at the rate of Forty Dollars per hour not to exceed Eighteen Thousand Dollars per year for the period of April 6, 2009 through April 5, 2010, with an option for yearly renewal; and
- **WHEREAS,** funding for same is available through the Livingston County Department of Public Health Budget #221.
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes entering into an agreement with Bonnita A. Detweiler for business management services for the Livingston County Department of Public Health at the rate of Forty Dollars per hour not to exceed Eighteen Thousand Dollars per year for the period of April 6, 2009 through April 5, 2010, together with an option for yearly renewal for services described above.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners be authorized to sign the above-referenced contract upon approval as to form by Civil Counsel.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, upon satisfactory performance of the contract, as determined by the County Administrator, the Board Chairperson be authorized to sign a yearly renewal as approved as to form by Civil Counsel.
