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**RESOLUTION TO LEVY 2010 ALLOCATION MILLAGE – Equalization / Finance Committee**

**WHEREAS,** in compliance with the requirements of Act 5, Public Acts of Michigan 1982, as amended; and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed levy would apportion taxes for county operating purposes based on the Taxable Valuation of \$7,953,592,697; and

**WHEREAS,** prior to the presentation of this resolution, the following tax levies were recommended:

<b>General Operations</b>	<b>3.3897</b>
<b>Ambulance</b>	<b>0.2945</b>
<b>Veterans Relief</b>	<b>0.0500</b>
<b>Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Auth.</b>	<b>0.2146</b>

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the apportionment of taxes for county operating purposes be approved and authorized to be levied on the summer tax billing against the Taxable Valuation of the County at the rate of 3.3897 mills.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Ambulance Millage, Veterans Relief Millage and Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority Millage be levied on the winter tax billing against the Taxable Valuation of the County at the rates of 0.2945, 0.0500 and 0.2146 respectively;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the 2010 levy for county operations and debt be approved and levied as recommended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners be authorized to sign the 2010 Millage Rate Request (L-4029) upon approval of the Board of Commissioners.
