    - **DISCUSSION**
      - The current Storage Area Network (SAN) is close to full capacity and a replacement is urgently needed.
      - A stop gap is not recommended as this may result in outages.
      - The SAN quoted by Dell is the most aggressively priced storage device.

- UltraLevel is a Dell partner and was recommended to Livingston County by Dell.
