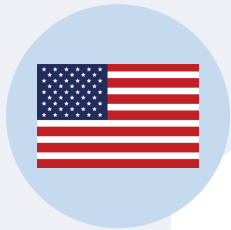


ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

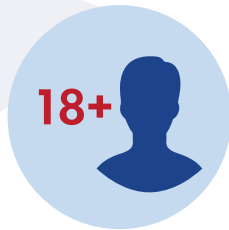


PRIMARY ELECTION • AUGUST 2, 2022

TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN MICHIGAN, YOU MUST:



Be a citizen of the United States of America



Be at least 18 years of age (by election day.) You can register when you are 17.5 years old



Be a resident of Michigan (at the time you register) and a resident of your City or Township for at least 30 days (when you vote)



Not be currently serving a sentence in jail or prison

REGISTER TO VOTE THROUGH ELECTION DAY

- In person at your City, Township, or County Clerk's Office

o You will be required to show acceptable photo ID proving identity or sign an affidavit

- By mail (postmarked by July 18th)
- At any Secretary of State branch office

- In person with your City or Township Clerk

o You will be required to show acceptable photo ID proving identity or sign an affidavit
(Proof of residency is required)
