

**PUBLIC ACCURACY TEST SCHEDULE**  
**November 2, 2021 City General - Special Election**

A preliminary accuracy test is required for all tabulators and VAT prior to each election. In addition, a **public test** of one or more selected tabulators must be performed. A public test of the voter assist terminal is not required.

The public accuracy test for the tabulator must be conducted no later than five days before the election. In addition, a notice of the test must be published in a newspaper or journal of general circulation at least 48 hours prior to the conduct of the test.

This test is done to determine that the equipment used to tabulate the votes does so in the accordance to Michigan Election Law.
