7. REPORT OF MANAGER

- Megan informed the CCAB that The Office of Community Corrections approved the Budget Adjustment Request, therefore Community Corrections can now start to assist in funding Substance Abuse testing for ADC felony participants. This will help to ensure that ADC participants receive the necessary treatment, as well as increase referrals for Community Corrections SUD programming.
- The other Community Corrections programs (TREM and Thinking Matters) are well underway with Key Development Center.
- Judge M. Hatty asked that Megan keep the new ADC Assistant Prosecutor, Scott Ehlfeldt, as well as Sara Applegate informed of the new developments.
- Judge M. Hatty also inquired about the status of the Pretrial Services pilot program. Megan reported that she's meeting with Roberta this week to discuss CC programs, including the pretrial services program. Megan is also attending a LEIN training on 1/20/21 which is an important part of pretrial services assessments. Roberta mentioned that there's a potential new source of funding through a grant that we'll be applying for.
