REQUEST FOR ORDER PERMITTING POSSESSION OF ELECTRONIC DEVICE(S)

Background

Generally, electronic devices such as cell phones or cameras are not permitted on the Court premises. These devices can be permitted only upon Order of the Court, for reasons approved by the Court on a case by case basis. Examples include bringing a cell phone or recorder to Court because it contains evidence that will be presented to the Court, or bringing a camera to a special Court proceeding such as an Adoption or Wedding.

ORDER PERMITTING POSSESSION OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES

A joint policy approved by the Chief Judge of the Trial Courts in Livingston County prohibits possession or use of cell phones in court facilities by all persons entering the facility, with limited exception.
