Field Name	Attribute Type	Description	Item Codes
ID	Integer	Unique number assigned to each address point	
FK_DEV_ID	Integer	Foreign key that connects to the Development table records	
FK_CONTACT	Text	Foreign key that connects to the Contacts table records	
FK_PARCEL_	Text	Foreign key that is the tax id number of the parcel that the address point is associated with; Can be used to link the address point with an export from BS&A; May be blank for addresses issued in right-of-way or where no parcel is located	
ADDR_NUM	Number	Number assigned to the address; house number	
PREDIR	Text	A pre-directional associated with a road's street name (N, S, E, W, etc.)	
RDNAME	Text	The street name assigned. The official street name is listed on recorded subdivision plats or condominium plans. If a street is located in an unplatted area, the official street name is recorded in the Livingston County Road Commission's Road Name Book.	
SUFFIX	Text	The street type (AVE, BLVD, RD, ST etc) assigned according to USPS standards	
SUFFDIR	Text	A post-directional associated with a road's street name (N, S, E, W, etc.)	
ZIP	Integer	5-digit USPS zipcode	
PRIM_TYPE	Text	Code used to show primary type of address	RES = Residential COMM = Commercial MTR = Meter XMPT = Exempt

CHANGE	Text	Change recommendation & history of address changes; Addresses that have been changed have two points on top of each other; 1 point has status = retired & the new address has a status of C (complete)	Y = Changed 1 = Not Urgent 2 = Somewhat Urgent 3 = Fairly Urgent 4 = Very Urgent
PREV_ADDR	Integer	ID of retired address record	
LOT_UNIT	Text	Development lot or unit number
