Livingston County Health Department Offering Free Flu Clinic on November 22

HOWELL, Michigan. - (November 12, 2020) The Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) will be offering a free drive-thru flu clinic on Sunday, November 22. All community members 6 months of age and older are welcome to attend.

Everyone 6 months and older needs a flu vaccine, especially this year. Widespread flu vaccination will reduce the spread of flu during the COVID-19 pandemic and can prevent or reduce serious illness and related hospitalizations or deaths. Flu vaccination can also reduce the chance of people becoming infected with both flu and COVID-19 at the same time.

Free Flu Vaccine Clinic Details:

When: Sunday, November 22 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm

Where: Livingston County Health Department Parking Lot
2300 East Grand River Avenue, Howell Michigan

No pre-registration is required for attending. When arriving for vaccinations, remember to wear your mask and comfortable clothing so that our nurses can access your upper arm.
