<b>Standard School Exclusion:</b>											
<b>Who can participate? All Livingston County K-12 school staff and students.</b>

<b>Exposure to COVID-19 Case</b>	<p>Monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. If symptoms develop, isolate immediately and get tested for COVID-19.</p> <p>Staff/Student <u>cannot</u> ride the bus, attend in-person school, participate in sports, in-person after school activities, or in-person extracurricular activities.</p> <p>Plan ahead. Schedule an appointment to receive a provider-administered test on Day 6 or 7 of the exclusion period (PCR or antigen tests are acceptable). Only one negative test result is required to return to school on Day 8. At-home test results will not be accepted.</p>					<p><b>Staff/Student can be tested for COVID-19 by a provider.</b> PCR or antigen tests are acceptable. At-home test results will <u>not</u> be accepted.</p> <p>Staff/Student <u>cannot</u> ride the bus, attend in-person school, participate in sports, in-person after school activities, or in-person extracurricular activities.</p>		<p><b>Provide proof of negative test result to the <u>school</u>.</b></p> <p>Staff/Student can return to school and participate in all activities <u>while wearing a mask</u>.</p> <p>It is recommended the staff/student monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. ## Alternate In-Person School Attendance:

To be eligible to participate in Alternate In-Person School Attendance, students must meet all the criteria listed below. Students who do not meet the criteria listed below may have the option of Standard School Exclusion or Standard School Exclusion with Testing.

### Alternate In-Person School Attendance Eligibility Requirements:

- Exposed individual is a student
- Exposure occurred in a school setting (this does not include exposures that occurred in the home or in the community)
- Student is notified 5 days or earlier into their exclusion period.
  - Per current protocol, all students are asked to stay at home until they complete their first at home test and report the results through our electronic system. In practice, this means that all students stay at home for one day. If a student is notified of their exposure after Day 5, the majority will only have one at home rapid antigen test administered which is insufficient to safely return to school.
- Student agrees to:
  - Daily testing for seven (7) days after exposure. Results will be reported to LCHD.
  - Daily symptom screening for seven (7) days after exposure. Results will be reported to LCHD.
  - Wear a mask at all times while in school for ten (10) days after exposure.
  - Not participate in other extracurricular activities (apart from taking the bus and going to class) for seven (7) days after exposure.
  - Isolate at home immediately if COVID-19 symptoms develop.

## Alternate In-Person School Attendance:

**Who can participate? Only Livingston County K-12 students who meet specific eligibility requirements. Some Livingston County schools have opted not to allow their students to participate in this testing option. Please contact the school for more information.**

<p><b>Exposure to COVID-19 Case</b></p>	<p><b>In order to participate in Alternate In-Person School Attendance, <u>daily</u> symptom checks and at-home COVID-19 testing are required through Day 7.</b></p> <p>This includes any weekends or holidays that may fall within this period.</p> <p>After the first at-home test is completed and reported within our electronic system, the student can ride bus and attend school <u>while wearing a mask</u>.</p> <p>The student <u>cannot</u> participate in sports, in-person after school activities, or in-person extracurricular activities.</p> <p>If symptoms develop or the student tests positive for COVID-19, stay home and isolate immediately.</p>							<p><b>Student can participate in all activities <u>while wearing a mask</u>.</b></p> <p>It is recommended the staff/student monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. If symptoms develop, it is recommended the staff/student isolate immediately and get tested for COVID-19.</p> <p>Daily testing no longer required.</p>		<p><b>Exclusion complete.</b></p> <p>Student can return to normal activities.</p> <p>Masking is strongly recommended, but not required.</p>	

## Fully Vaccinated Staff/Students:

**Fully vaccinated staff/students who remain asymptomatic do not need to be excluded from school.** An individual is considered fully vaccinated if:

- 2 weeks have passed since their second dose of a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
- 2 weeks have passed since their single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson’s Janssen vaccine.

It is recommended that fully vaccinated individuals get tested 5-7 days after an exposure to COVID-19 and wear a mask for 14 days (or until a negative COVID-19 test result is recorded 5-7 days after the exposure). **To report your student's vaccination status visit <https://bit.ly/3kzyqu5>.**
