This year, the only Project Fresh market in Livingston County is Madison Closet and Farm, a roadside market on Oak Grove Rd.

It is open 7 days a week from 8am-8pm.

In addition, there will be one independent farmer selling raspberries at the Howell Farmer's Market toward the end of summer.

What is Project Fresh?

WIC Project FRESH helps to provide healthy and nutritious produce to Michigan WIC clients. The program provides WIC clients with fresh locally grown fruits and vegetables from authorized farmers, farmers' markets and roadside stands throughout Michigan.

How Do WIC Project FRESH Coupons Work?

Enrolled WIC clients may be eligible to receive a \$25 booklet containing five, \$5 coupons to be used June 1st through October 31st at authorized farmers, farmers' markets and roadside stands throughout Michigan. Coupon books will be available to be picked up at the WIC office on a first come, first served basis on Wednesday, July 10, 17, 24 & 31.

What May Be Purchased With WIC Project FRESH Coupons?

Only fresh fruits and vegetables and several herbs are allowed to be purchased. Items not allowed include: honey, maple syrup, cider, nuts, eggs, meats and cheese.
