How can I get an appointment for the COVID-19 vaccine?

If you are able, fill out the vaccination interest form on our website and you will be contacted once vaccine is available. If you cannot complete the form online, call 211 and ask for assistance signing up to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Please reserve phone lines for those who cannot access online resources. If you have other questions or concerns, e-mail COVID19@livgov.com and we will respond as soon as we can.



I submitted the form, but I don't know if you got my information?

After you submit the vaccination interest form you should see a thank you screen. You will also receive a confirmation email from noreply@alchemer.com. If you do not see the confirmation email in your inbox, please check your junk or spam folder. You will receive a follow up e-mail or phone call to schedule your appointment once we are able to vaccinate your group.

When will I be vaccinated? How are individuals chosen for vaccination?

We are working to schedule vaccine appointments as fast as we can, but we're limited by supply. Future vaccine shipment dates and quantities are not guaranteed, so we cannot provide estimated vaccination dates. Individuals who completed the interest form will be sorted by priority groups and randomly selected to schedule appointments as they become available.



I have filled out the form for my elderly loved one, but they do not have an e-mail address or internet access. How will you make sure they get a chance to schedule?

We will be reaching out by phone to schedule appointments for those who do not have e-mail. Because we will be scheduling appointments for hundreds of people, it will take us some time to reach everyone. Alternatively, you may put your own e-mail in on your relative's behalf.

Where are vaccination clinics located?

Locations of vaccine sites are determined prior to a clinic being scheduled and are based on the population being served and the amount of vaccine being provided at the clinic. This information is not released until a clinic is set and opened for registration.



Where else can I get vaccinated in Livingston County?

Please check your healthcare system's website to see if vaccination is available through them. While COVID-19 vaccine supply is still very limited, some local healthcare systems have received enough vaccine to open a limited number of appointments for their patients.

As vaccine supplies increase, more appointments will be available. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
