Understanding Shelter and Housing Resources in Livingston County (LC):

- Shelter support is available for those who live and work in LC
- These funds are very limited and can only be accessed once per year
- Shelter support (hotel vouchers) is only available for around 2 – 4 weeks
- Once you have used these resources, there are no additional shelter resources in LC. It takes 3 – 9+ months to find stable housing in LC
