# Coordinated Response

**LACASA:**

Still providing services. The group services are postponed at this time, but still providing CARE services, counseling, SANE, legal, shelter and hotel rooms as needed.

**The Salvation Army:**

TSA continues all current social services including **Utility assistance** and **housing and shelter assistance** at regular scheduled days and times but call office first. The food pantry is open and the Mobile Canteen is being deployed. Please call Marlena Poff at **517-546-4750 x 346** for more information. **Appointments are required** and most business will be conducted over the phone.

**Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency (OLHSA):**

OLHSA remains committed to our community and the services we provide.

OLHSA remains open to provide **emergency housing** and **shelter services**. However, any households that may need to access these services **please call the office at 517-546-8500**. Most business will be conducted over the phone and electronically to follow the recommended guidelines of social distancing.

**The Connection Youth Services:**

- The emergency shelter will remain available to take youth who meet the shelter eligibility criteria.
- Case Managers and therapists will connect via telephone to ensure basic needs and any safety concerns are addressed.
- The following groups are cancelled: iGrow, Negotiations, Life Skills, TLP Group, Relaxation, and the Umbrella "Initiative."
- The Drop In Center will be open from 2:00pm-5:00pm Monday-Thursday for youth to receive basic need and food items. We will not be serving a meal at the Center, however, we will have food for youth to take with them.

**Evictions on Hold:** Landlord Tenant cases scheduled through April 3, 2020 are adjourned to April 9, 2020. Landlords can still file for evictions, but the judge will not hear them until April 9th.
