



## **Chore and Home Injury Control Programs**

OLHSA's Chore program provides various types of home and yard work to assist older adults, 60 years or older, who can no longer maintain their yards and homes. Services include lawn mowing, snow removal over two inches and minor home repairs. These services are donation-based and no one will be turned away due to inability to pay.

OLHSA's Home Injury Control program delivers and installs all types of devices that allow greater comfort or mobility to frail, older adults aged 60 years or older. Items may help assure the safety of older adults in the bathroom, at night, in emergencies, and during everyday routines. Some examples of devices are raised toilet seats, tub grab bars, handheld showerheads, and tub mats. Safety Handbooks are passed out when devices are installed and are available for download from our website.

You can access these programs in four different ways.
