Livingston County Transportation Coalition

What is the Transportation Coalition (TC)?

The Transportation Coalition is a Human Services Collaborative Body working group. TC works to improve the quality of local transportation through public involvement (including walking, biking, driving, public transportation, etc).

When and where does Transportation Coalition Meet?

The Transportation Coalition meets monthly on the second Tuesday of each month from 3:30-4:30PM at the Livingston County Public Health Building. The public is always welcome and encouraged to attend Transportation Coalition meetings.

If you need a ride to work, and you meet income guidelines, you may be eligible to ride the L.E.T.S. JARC Bus (average cost is \$2 per ride). Call LETS for more information (517.546.6600) & remember personal aides ride for free.
