Teams can play for fun, learning new ways to be better environmental stewards, or teams can play to win cool "green" prizes and fun experiences from participating local organizations. Played on a smartphone using the free GooseChase App, The Livingston County Earth Day Challenge will include approximately 30 "missions". Teams can pick and choose which missions to accept and complete over Earth Day Weekend, submitting "proof" of completion through the app in the form of photos, videos or text responses.
