**TREND:**

During the 2010 and 2020 decade Livingston County's gain in number of households has slowed compared to previous decades with a percent growth of 10.2% compared to a 21.7% growth in the previous 2000 - 2010 decade. The southeast quadrant of the county (Brighton, Genoa, Hamburg, Green Oak Townships and the City of Brighton) is still experiencing the largest growth in households. The southeast quadrant added 2,576 new households, with Green Oak Township leading the way with a 14.0% growth in households (902 new households). Among all Livingston County communities, Oceola Township showed the most growth in households (1,210).
