TREND:

During the 2010 and 2020 decade Livingston County's growth in housing units has slowed compared to previous decades, with a percent growth of 7.7% compared to a 23.6% growth in the previous 2000 - 2010 decade. Growth in housing units within the southeast quadrant of the county has also slowed and has been surpassed for the first time by housing unit growth in the northeast quadrant (Oceola, Hartland, Tyrone and Deerfield Townships). The northeast quadrant added 2,225 housing units, with Oceola Township leading the way with a 26.9% growth in housing units (1,143 new units). Among Livingston County's cities and villages, the City of Howell showed the most growth in housing units (209).
