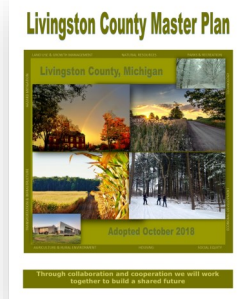


Trail Summit
