TREND:

Michigan's population topped 10 million in 2020. The state's population of 10,077,331 is up 193,691 residents from the 2010 Census, for a 2% growth. Livingston County's 2020 Census population growth moved the County from the 11th most populous county in Michigan to the number 10 spot. Livingston surpassed Saginaw County to move from 11th to 10th most populous county in Michigan. Livingston County is the 6th fastest growing county in the state in terms of percent population change (7.1%); Ottawa, Grand Traverse, Kent, Allegan, and Washtenaw counties had higher percent population changes between the 2010 Census and 2020 Census.
