### **New Countywide Generalized Zoning Map**

The Livingston County Planning Department has partnered with Livingston County Geographic Information Systems (GIS) to bring this new map to the GIS Interactive Map Gallery on the Livingston County website.

Zoning data was collected by County Planning Staff and reviewed and revised through meetings with each local unit of government. The zoning categories of each municipality were then generalized into a common set of zoning categories (see available legend) so that by viewing the map one can get an idea of overall zoning patterns in Livingston County and where zoning amendments may be needed to create logical transitions between municipalities. With this data, the GIS Technician has created an interactive [Countywide Generalized Zoning Map](#). A user of the map can click on any community in the county and zoom in to further refine the view to show the actual local zoning classification of individual parcels. A search box enables the user to search the zoning information by parcel identification number. Full user instructions are available on the map.

Livingston County Planning and GIS will be maintaining this map as zoning districts change over time. As with all new products, each local unit of government should contact us if there are revisions that need to be made.
