**TREND:**

The child population under age 18 has decreased in most Livingston County communities over the 20-year, 2000-2020 time period, while the population age 18 and up has increased. In most Livingston County communities, as well as Livingston County as a whole, 20% or more of the 2020 population is comprised of persons under age 18; the exceptions are Deerfield, Hamburg, Putnam and Unadilla Townships as well as the cities of Brighton and Howell. Brighton Township has the largest child population (4,362) in Livingston County. The townships in the southeast quadrant of the County have the largest voting age population age 18 and up (Brighton, Genoa, Hamburg and Green Oak Townships).
