Child Care Financial Assistance Policy

The payment of child care will be allocated to the “Non-Emergent Relief Fund” under line item “Veterans Child Care Relief Fund”. This fund will be made available to honorably discharged Veterans and their Surviving Spouses, who are Livingston County residents, with 90 days of Active Duty Service and at least one day of service in the following periods of conflict *OR have an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal*.

WWII	Dec. 02, 1941 to	Dec. 31, 1946
Korea	June 27, 1950 to	Jan. 31, 1955
Vietnam	Feb. 28, 1961 to	May 7, 1975
Persian Gulf	Aug. 02, 1990	to TBD

Individuals requesting child care will be required to complete an application for relief, reason for need, two estimates from a *licensed* day care provider and estimated time for need. The Committee may choose to pay all or a portion of or deny on a case by case basis.

All applications will come before the Veterans Services Committee for initial approval and every four months thereafter up to two renewals or until applicant or Veterans Services Committee deems service is no longer needed.

Proof of work will be required on a bi-weekly basis and/or proof of training on a monthly basis and will be the responsibility of the applicant to provide information to assigned counselor. All training and education must be from an accredited institution and applicant will be required to keep a cumulative 2.0 (C) gpa. Failure to do so will result in stopped payments.

The Veterans Services Committee reserves the right to discontinue assistance at any time for any reason.

Funding for policy is dependent on yearly budget constraints.
